Exwick Parish Hall continues to be a creative hub for the community, with two fantastic groups offering space to relax, learn new skills, and connect with others through art and craft.



### Update from Felix - CPAO

Some of you may be aware that we had planned a large family-friendly Walking Sports Festival to take place at the Exwick Playing Fields on Sun 20<sup>th</sup> July. After lots of work planning and organising the event, we had to postpone it due to severe weather warnings the day before. This was very disappointing and we are now working hard to make sure that the festival still happens on a different date in the coming months. Keep an eye on my Facebook page

On the day, the Exwick Playing Fields will be transformed into a festival space for several hours of free drop-in taster sessions. Among other things, this is likely to include Walking Cricket, Walking Football, Non-Contact T1 Rugby and more. With the help of our experienced coaches, this will be an amazing opportunity to try your hands (and feet) at these inclusive walking sports, suitable for any age (16+) and ability.

As the name suggests, walking sports are modified versions of the traditional sports they emerged from. Pitches and courts are often smaller, while balls and other equipment may be lighter. There is usually limited or no contact, with an emphasis on gentle pace rather than strenuous exercise. All of these sports are very accessible and inclusive regardless of age, gender and ability.

The event will also include kids' activities, so parents can bring their children and let them have fun while trying out any of the sports on offer. We are also making plans to have music as well as refreshments.

Come and join us for a chance to play, socialise and enjoy a fun day out this summer!




